Tournament Rules:

- 1) The tournament is being played at all four CCISD High Schools. Each team is guaranteed a minimum of three games and a maximum of five (final two teams-Championship Game)
- 2) \$40 entry fee – Have checks made out to Clear Creek Baseball, and send them to CCHS – Mallory

- 3) High School Federation rules will apply
- 4) Creek, Lake, Brook and Springs will be home teams. Otherwise home team will be determined by a coin flip. ( also when two CCISD teams play.)
- 5) Games will be six innings or one hour and forty-five minute time limit, which ever comes first.  
(Finish the inning)
- 6) Each team provides two balls at the start of their game to the umpire.
- 7) Game tie-breaker rule: If a game is tied after 6innings of play or after time has expired, the following will determine the winner:
  - a. most runners to reach 3<sup>rd</sup> safely
  - b. most runners to reach 2<sup>nd</sup> safely
  - c. team with the most hits from the official book kept upstairs
  - d. coin flip
- 8) The offensive team is responsible for chasing foul balls. – You hit. You RETREIVE>
- 9) No pre-game infield or batting practice on the field. Batting practice can occur only in the cages before the game. One cage per team. NO CLEATS IN CAGES!
- 10) No soft toss into fences, and please PICK UP YOUR TRASH in the dugouts following your game and in the cages after use.
- 11) Tie breaker system to determine site winner that advances to the semi-finals played on Saturday @ Creek. (Wins vs. Losses)
  - a. head to head
  - b. run total – least given up
  - c. run total – most scored
  - d. coin flip
- 12) Championship Game and Semi-Finals (same as #5)
